



COURSE RULES

The Royal and Ancient St. Andrews Rules of Golf Apply

OUT OF BOUNDS, a ball coming to rest over any boundary fence or beyond a line of white stakes is deemed out of bounds. The driving range is **OUT OF BOUNDS** and balls may not be retrieved.

All water hazards (yellow stakes) and lateral water hazards (red stakes) are clearly defined.

Stones in bunkers may be removed

A ball coming to rest in G.U.R. **MUST BE** lifted and dropped one club length without penalty at the nearest point of relief.

Areas designated "Environmentally Protected Area" (white and green stakes), are deemed **Out of Bounds** and balls **MUST NOT BE** retrieved.

If a ball comes to rest underneath any cactus tree the ball **MUST BE** dropped within one club length at the nearest point of relief without penalty.

Drop zones on holes 10, 11, 15, 16. Players have the option of keeping the point of entry between the player and the flag (water hazard red stakes) or taking relief under penalty of one shot.

Artificial pathways are deemed G.U.R.

Golf Carts may only be driven on Cart Paths. Keep carts 30 feet away from Greens.
